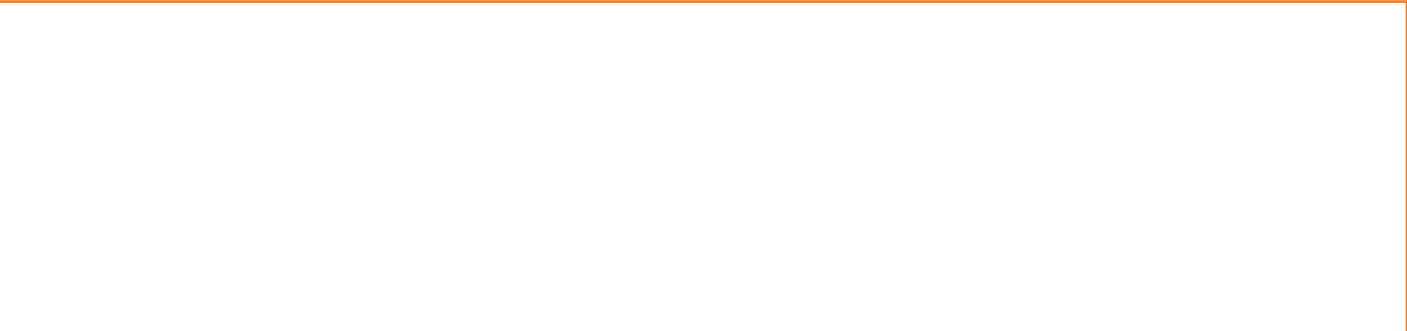

MISSION STATEMENT

Joyfull Life exists to empower children with disabilities by providing access to inclusive care, education, and rehabilitation through collaboration with charitable organizations, humanitarian groups, and community partners to ensure every child can thrive with dignity and hope.



A BRIEF HISTORY OF JOYFUL LIFE

In 2012, Joyful Life became a charitable organization by registering with the charity and society agency. However, it was founded earlier than 8 years ago by its visionary founder, Seblewengel Bekele (Sabrina Orgino), who had 16 children, through a selection process with the Keble administration to help the most impoverished people. Some of the kids were so weak from not being able to eat on a regular basis that they were unable to stand on their own two feet while they were in school. Joyful Life has therefore taken the admirable step to assist the kids and their family ever since that time. Support was provided for school supplies, clothes, uniforms, health insurance, and wholesome breakfasts.

Joy Full Life (JFL) is a non-profit, non-political, and non-religious charity organization based in Ethiopia that focuses on providing essential medical, health education, and livelihood support to children with disabilities. The organization also assists families living in extreme poverty.

A BRIEF HISTORY OF JOYFUL LIFE

JFL was initially established in 2004, and was legally re-registered under the Ethiopian Civil Society Organization (CSO) law as "Joyful Life" on November 25, 2020, and obtained its legal license under Registration Law 2676.

Joyfull Life works in partnerships with local and international organizations and also with local governments to better achieve its objectives.

- To provide children with disabilities access to quality rehabilitation, education, and support programs.
- To empower families and caregivers with training, resources, and guidance to improve the well-being and inclusion of children with disabilities
- To advocate for the rights of children with disabilities and raise public awareness to reduce stigma and foster inclusive communities.

JOYFUL LIFE FOR DEVELOPMENT

JFL focuses on the following areas to achieve its vision of disability equality and social assimilation:
Advocacy relevant to disabled children including:

- Providing physical, occupational, speech and psychological therapy tailored to the needs of children with disabilities.
- Offering counseling, training, and resources to empower families in caring for children with disabilities.
- Conducting campaigns and initiatives to promote social inclusion, reduce stigma, and advocate for children's rights.
- Building strong networks with charitable organizations, humanitarian groups, government agencies, and local communities to maximize reach and impact.

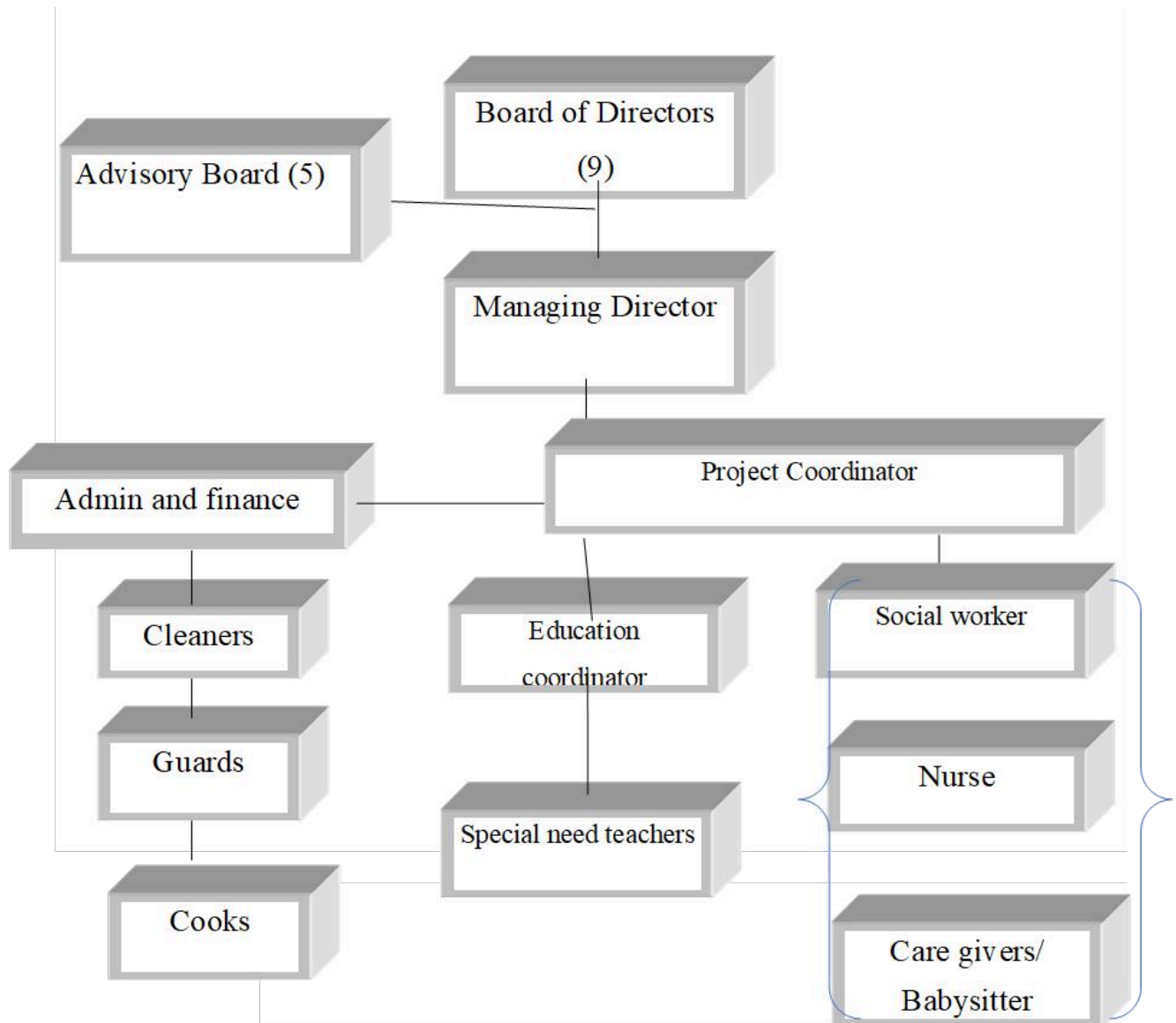
JOYFUL LIFE FOR DEVELOPMENT
